

Byron Rototiller / Storage Shed Policy

Prior to operating the tiller or using the storage shed referenced in this Policy the following must be signed and on file with City Hall.

Scope

This policy applies to Byron community garden members who use the tiller owned by the City of Byron.

Purpose

1. To provide clarity on the use of the tiller and who may operate it, as well as provide for the soil preparation needs of the Community Garden members.
2. To provide storage space for Community Garden related assets and limited storage space for gardeners.

Policy Statement

As part of the agreement between community garden plot renters and the city, renters expect to have their plots rototilled once per year.

Byron has made a storage shed available for community garden participants. The City of Byron is not responsible for theft or lost items from this shed or the community gardens in their entirety. All community garden members will have access to the building to store tools and materials the members hold in common for use in the gardens. The City shall retain all rights to the shed and may terminate its use at any time at their discretion.

Indemnification

The community garden members agrees to protect, defend, indemnify and hold the City of Byron, its elected officials, employees and agents, free and harmless from and against any and all losses, penalties, damages, settlements, costs, charges, professional fees or other expenses or liabilities of every kind and character arising out of or relating to any and all claims, liens, demands, obligations, actions, proceedings or causes of action of every kind and character (hereinafter collectively "claims") in connection with or arising directly or indirectly out of the Byron Rototiller Policy or the performance hereof by the selected garden participants. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, any and all such claims, relating to personal injury, infringement of any patent, trademark, copyright (or application for any thereof) or of any other tangible or intangible personal or property rights, or actual or alleged violation of any applicable statute, ordinance, administrative order, rule of regulation, or decree of any court, shall be included in the indemnity hereunder.

The community garden members agrees to investigate, handle, respond to, provide defense for, and defend any such claims, at its sole expense and agrees to bear all other costs and expenses related thereto, whether or not it is alleged or determined that the selected member was negligent, and without regard to whether such claim is groundless, false, or fraudulent.
